Burning bush moments or experiences in our lives.

Can you remember your burning bush moment or moments? A moment or an experience when you felt you were in the presence of God. A moment or experience that was different in some inexplicable way. How did you react to this experience? Did you feel puzzled, but also strangely at peace. During this moment or event did you find a thought/idea coming to you that had never come to you before, a positive thought that helped you find a solution to a recurring problem in your life, a thought that suggested a new direction to your life, a thought relating to a new person in your life or a person in your life that you now saw in a new more positive way. How did you react to this moment/ event/ idea? Did you want to draw nearer and engage more with this idea? Did you disengage with the thought/idea only to find that it returned a few days, months, or even years later? Try to remember the burning bush moments or experiences in your life. It is here that you will find the source of your spirituality, the way to developing a deeper personal relationship with God, who will show you your authentic self, your true self. Remember them and treasure them. These moments usually occur before you make a life changing decision.
