Trócaire Lenten Campaign 2026

Trócaire boxes are available in each of the churches. The focus of this year's campaign is Rwanda where families who rely on farming to survive are facing the worst of the global climate crisis. Severe storms are striking faster and more often, sweeping away roads, homes, schools and crops.

With men away seeking work in the cities, the women are left to farm the fields in order to try and feed their families and hold their communities together.

Trócaire has formed partnerships with local organisations in Rwanda to help those poorer and marginalised rural communities.

Your generous support enables Trócaire to provide the longer term assistance needed to help families cope with the impact of climate change and to build resilience for future generations.

Cork and Ross Lourdes Pilgrimage

As with last year, we plan to go to Lourdes as a parish group to join the wider diocesan family. The cost is €1,049 and we will stay in the Hotel La Solitude.

People are also encouraged to join as helpers (male and female), nurses and doctors to assist pilgrims in Lourdes.
