## \*\*Health & Safety Notice\*\*

At recent meetings of our Parish Pastoral Council the issue of parking has been discussed on a number of occasions.

So, we kindly ask you to please note and to be aware of the following. There are now new markings in the car parks of Little Island Church and Glounthaune Church.

**Little Island Church:** To the right of the entrance gate as you enter the car park **must** be kept clear. This is now clearly marked and will allow for the safe and free flow of traffic entering and exiting the church grounds.

**Glounthaune Church:** We respectfully ask that the limited spaces within the church yard be left free for use by those with disability parking permits and those who may have mobility issues. There is also a disability parking permit space in the Church Centre car park.

However, If you do park in the church yard, please be aware of pedestrians. In the interest of health and safety of your fellow parishioners, we kindly ask that you do not reverse your car or attempt to drive out until the majority of pedestrians have left. Normally this doesn't take very long.

We thank you for your co-operation, patience and understanding as we try to keep all who attend both churches safe and free from any unforeseen incidents.
