Saints Peter and Paul

Sunday 29th June is the Feast of two Apostles considered to be the founders of the church.

Saint Peter, originally called Simon was a fisherman. He was one of the first Apostles called by Jesus who named him Peter to be the rock upon which he would build his Church. He became the leader of the Apostles and the first Pope. He died by crucifixion in Rome in the period 64 and 68 AD.

Saint Paul, known as Saul, was not one of the original Apostles and had been a persecutor of the early church until his conversion on the road to Damascus. Paul then became a key figure in spreading Christianity to the non-Jewish world and is known as the Apostle of the Gentiles. Paul was martyred by beheading around 67 AD.

Hearing Loop

A hearing loop is installed in this church. This provides a wireless signal that is picked up by hearing aids and improves sound from electronic equipment within the loop when the hearing aid is switched to the 'T' (Telecoil) setting.

By switching your hearing aid to the T setting you should hear the church speaker sound more clearly. Please remember you may need to reset your hearing aid to the M setting for normal hearing outside the Hearing Loop area.

The majority of modern hearing aids can be adjusted between an M and a T setting. If your hearing aid does not have this facility, ask your audiologist when you next visit.
